

Financial Controller

Job Description: We are looking for a Financial Controller to join us on-site and then quickly grow into the lead for our accountancy team (currently one on-site accountant and a highly skilled team of remote consultants and vendors). You will learn the financial side of Senseker's business (both service and product businesses) and our ERP, Acumatica-based JAMIS Prime. You will manage general company bank accounts, accounting operations, accounting vendors, and US Government DCMA/DCAA and tax authority interactions. You will report to the CEO and need to communicate effectively with the leadership team of non-accountants (mostly engineering and business backgrounds). You must also be adept at communicating with US Government regulators, customers and vendors and always convey expertise and professionalism to all. This is a new role and the existing team will remain in place. You will have up to six months to learn our systems, business and team before you will take pole position (depending on your existing experience) and we expect you to learn by doing and contribute significantly during that time. Senseker is expanding and there will be significant opportunity for you to help build the systems you always wished you had and make your mark on this company as we grow.

Required Education & Work Experience: Bachelor's in Accounting with a minimum of seven years of experience.

- Oversee and use JAMIS Prime ERP for financial controller data generation, reports and entry
- Take lead on cashflow management, overseeing our cashflow modeling and recurring cashflow meetings with program management
- Take charge of building internal processes and controls that make sense for our business and are built for company growth
- Ensure all bookkeeping is correct, current and complies with US Government and state regulations
- Compile data and build models to help the leadership team make sound financial decisions
- Back-up existing accountant for payroll, AP & AR as needed
- Assist other accounting staff in building cost proposals for service projects and review cost inputs from the business and technical team
- Lead financial planning activities including yearly budgeting activities and regular budget reviews
- Act as the lead interface with financial services suppliers such as state and federal tax accountants, ERP consultants and US Government system consultants (such as ICE modeling)
- Act as the lead interface with government financial authorities such as DCMA and DCAA

Required Attributes:

- Experience with cost-type US Government contracting – candidates without this will not be considered
- Excellent mathematical and analytical capabilities
- High level of integrity and professionalism, representing the company well in front of customers, vendors and government compliance teams
- Organized and willing to dive deep into the details

- Experience with enterprise resource planning systems, JAMIS Prime or Acumatica a plus.

- Excellent communication and presentation skills for information delivery to executive-level management
